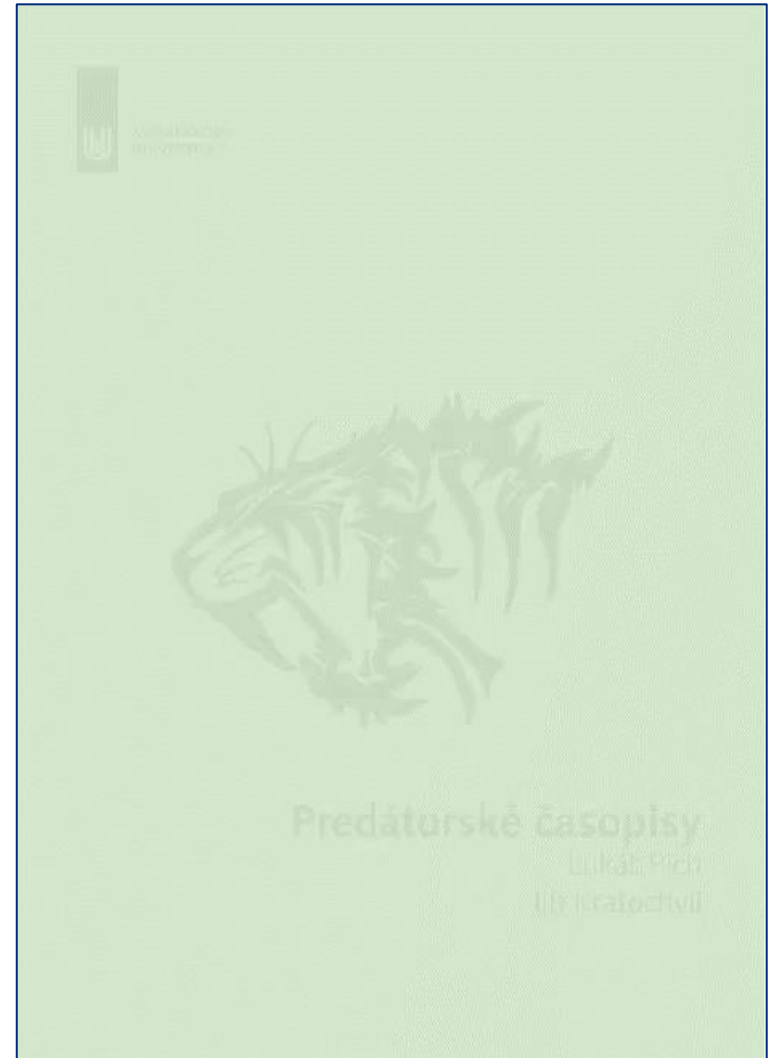

## Support – Scholarly Journal Predatory Attributes Occurrence Analysis

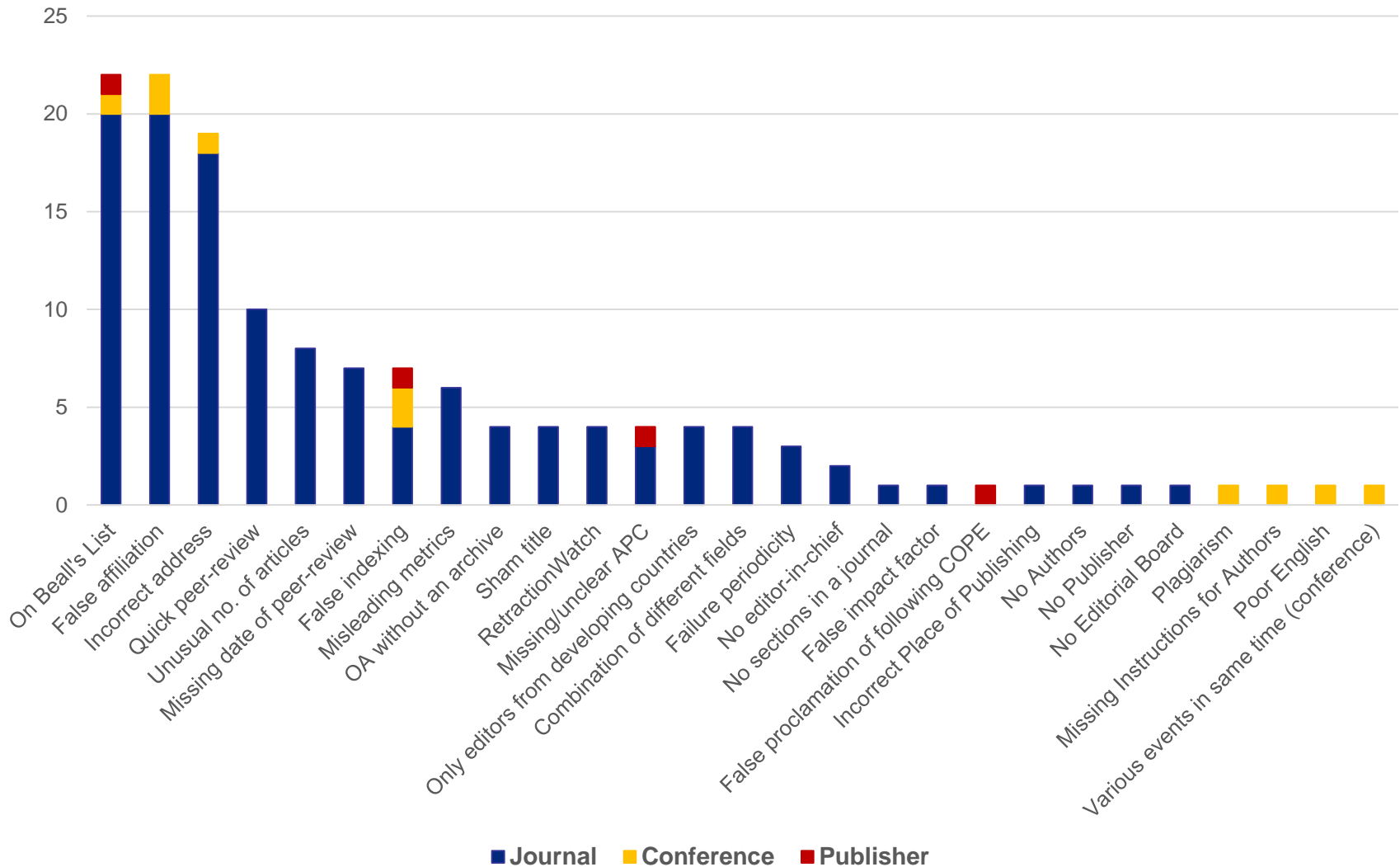
- New service since February 2017
